

Furasep®

(Nitrofurazone Cream)

Description

Furasep cream is a preparation of 0.2% Nitrofurazone. Nitrofurazone is a broad spectrum topical antibacterial agent indicated for the treatment of mixed skin infections of superficial wounds and diseases of the skin.

Indications

Furasep is indicated in the infectious conditions of the skin such as burns, wounds, ulcers, skin infections and skin grafting.

Dosage and Administration

To be applied directly to the lesion or on gauze first; 2-3 times daily or as advised by the physician.

Contraindication

Furasep is contraindicated to patients with known sensitivity to Nitrofurazone. It is not advisable to use Furasep after the infection is cured. It should be used with caution in patients with known or suspected renal impairment.

Side Effects

Sensitization and generalized allergic skin reactions may be produced after few days of initial application. Cross sensitization to other Nitrofurazone derivatives may occur. Intolerance to Nitrofurazone necessitating withdrawal has been encountered.

Commercial Pack

Furasep® Cream : Tube containing 20 g cream, each gram contains Nitrofurazone USP 2 mg.
